3/4 Yard Blender Blue	3/4 Yard Blender Aqua	3/4 Yard Blender Brown
3/4 Yard Blender Red	3/4 Yard Blender Sage	3/4 Yard Blender Orange
1/2 Yard Blender Red (binding)	1/2 Yard Flowers (binding)	1/2 Yard Fall Black (binding)
1-1/2 Yards Backing	1-1/2 Yards Backing	1-1/2 Yards Backing

READ THROUGH ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE BEGINNING. SEW PIECES RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER AND USE A 1/4 SEAM ALLOWANCE THROUGHOUT UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED. WOF = WIDTH OF FABRIC; HR = HALF RECTANGES; HST = HALF SQUARE TRIANGLES

IF USING A DIFFERENT METHOD VERIFY THE SIZE TO CUT FABRIC AND METHOD TO CREATE THE UNITS, ADDITIONAL FABRIC MAY BE NEEDED. PRESS SEAMS OPEN TO REDUCE BULK.

CUTTING:

From ANESH Panel:

Fussy cut [1] — Winter season motif to 12-1/2'' square **(A)**

From Stripe Fabric:

Fussy cut [2] of winter sections — 12-1/2" \times 2-1/2" strips (B)

Fussy cut [2] of winter sections — 16-1/2" \times 2-1/2" strips (C)

From Beach Blue, Summer Cream, Summer Blue, Flowers, Spring Cream, Spring Yellow, Fall Black , Fall Cream and Leaves Fabric:

(Use whichever fabrics are in your seasonal quilt)

Cut either [1 or 2] $- 4-1/2'' \times WOF$ strips, depending on how many squares are in your quilt. Cut [1] strip if there are [8] or less 4-1/2'' squares, cut [2] strips if more.

Subcut strips into appropriate 4-1/2" squares (D)

From Blender Blue, Blender Red, Blender Aqua, Blender Sage, Blender Brown and Blender Orange Fabric:

(Use whichever fabrics are in your seasonal quilt) Cut [3] $- 4-1/2'' \times$ WOF strips With fabric facing up subcut [64] HR using

template **(E)** or the Corner Curve Quilts Acrylic Template CCQ 4 x 2 HR **(E)**


Cut [3] $- 3'' \times$ WOF strips Subcut [32] - 3'' squares **(F)**

Cut bias 2-1/2" strips to equal 172" for binding

BLOCK ASSEMBLY:


Two at a Time HST Method:

- 1. Draw a line down the center diagonally on the wrong side of Blender Blue 3" squares (F).
- 2. Lay Holly Black 3" squares **(F)** right side up.
- 3. Place Blender Blue 3" squares **(F)** on top of the Holly Black square with right sides together.
- 4. Sew a 1/4'' seam from each side of drawn line.
- 5. Cut apart on drawn line.
- 6. Press HST open.
- 7. Trim to 2-1/2" square **(F/F)**.
- 8. Repeat steps 1-7 to make [64] 2-1/2" HST (F/F).



Half Triangle:

- 1. With RST line up Blender Blue **(E)** and Holly Black **(E)** on the long side of the triangles as shown.
- 2. Sew. Press.
- 3. Make [64] 4-1/2" x 2-1/2" HR (E/E).



Twisted Churn Dash Block Assembly:

1. Arrange [4] HST **(F/F)**, [4] HR **(E/E)** and [1] Winter square (D) to assemble the blocks as shown.

Note: the which color of the **(E/E)** is touching the center square **(D)** on the top and bottom of the block and on the sides.

2. Sew. Press.

QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY:

- Sew (B) to each side of ANESH Panel block (A). Press.
- 2. Sew **(C)** to top and bottom of ANESH Panel block **(A)**. Press.

BORDER:

- Create side units by alternating [2] Beach Blue 4-1/2" squares (D) and [2] Summer Cream 4-1/2" squares (D). For Fall use Fall Black and Fall Cream; for Spring use Flowers and Spring Cream.
- 2. Sew vertically in [2] columns of [4] squares, alternating squares following layouts shown below. Press.
- 3. Sew vertical units from Step 2 onto Quilt Top Assembly as shown. Press.



- Create top and bottom units by alternating [3] Beach Blue 4-1/2" squares (D) and [3] Summer Cream 4-1/2" squares (D).
- 5. Sew horizontally in [2] rows of [6] squares, alternating squares following layouts shown below. Press.
- 6. Sew horizontal row from Step 5 onto Quilt top Assembly as shown. Press.





Outside Border

- 1. Arrange [3] Twisted Churn Dash Blocks, as vertically as shown below.
- 2. Sew. Press. Make [2].
- 3. Sew to the left and right sides of Panel unit.




- 4. Arrange [5] Churn Dash Blocks horizontally, as shown below.
- 5. Sew. Press. Make [2].
- 6. Sew to the top and bottom sides of Panel unit.
- 7. Stay stitch 1/8" all the way around the quilt top to secure the edge of the quilt top.



FINISHING:

- 1. Layer quilt top with batting and backing.
- 2. Quilt as desired.
- 3. Position the 2-1/2" circular template in each corner and cut the outer edge.
- 4. Bind with bias binding.
- 5. Label & Enjoy!
