CUTTING:**Block 1 – Blueberry Star**

Gather:

[1] Cloud 2-1/2" × 22" strip

[1] Cloud 6" square

[1] Indigo 2-1/2" × 22" strip

[1] Blueberries 4-1/2" square

[2] Blueberries 6" squares

[1] Pool 6" squares

1. Draw a diagonal line on the back of the Cloud 6" square and Pool 6" square. Place RST on the Blueberry 6" squares. Sew 1/4" to each side of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line yielding [4] HSTs.



2. Place the HSTs from Step 1 RST with the seams nesting. Colors should be opposite. Draw a diagonal line corner to corner opposite the seam. Sew 1/4" on either side of the drawn line. Cut in half on the line. Square to 4-1/2". Yields [4] QST units.



3. Sew the Cloud 2-1/2" × 22" strip to the Indigo 2-1/2" × 22" strip lengthwise. Cut [8] – 2-1/2" units from the strip set.



4. Sew the units from Step 3 into 4-patch units. 4-patches should measure 4-1/2".



5. Sew 4-patch units to right and left sides of a QST unit, watching the direction of the squares as shown. Make [2].



6. Sew the remaining QST units to each side of the Blueberries 4-1/2" square.



7. Assemble the rows from Steps 5 and 6 to create the block as shown. Square to 12-1/2" as needed.



Block 2 – Flower & Lighthouses Square

Gather:

- [4] Paprika 3-1/2" squares
- [4] Canary 1-1/2" squares
- [4] Pool 2" squares
- [8] Pool 1-1/4" squares
- [1] Lighthouse 6-1/2" square

1. Draw a diagonal line on the back of all the Pool and Canary squares. Place Pool 1-1/4" squares on opposite corners of the Paprika square. Sew on the line. Trim the seam allowance to 1/4". Press [1] side out to the corner and the other to the Paprika square. Make [4].



2. Place a Pool 2" square on a corner of the unit from Step 1. Place a Canary 1-1/2" square on the remaining corner. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the seam allowance to 1/4". Press [2] of the blocks out to the corner square and [2] into the Paprika. Make [4].



3. Sew the [4] units from Step 3 together to form the flower. Seams should nest. Square to 6-1/2" as needed.



4. Sew a Lighthouse 6-1/2" square to the right side of the flower from Step 3. Square to 12-1/2" x 6-1/2" as needed.



Block 3 – Pinwheel & Blueberries Square

Gather:

- [2] Cloud 4" squares
- [2] Indigo 4" squares
- [1] Blueberries 6-1/2" square

1. Draw a diagonal line on the back of the Cloud squares. Place RST on the Indigo squares. Sew 1/4" to either side of the line. Cut on the drawn line. Press to the Indigo. Yields [4] HSTs. Trim to 3-1/2".



2. Sew the HSTs together as shown.



3. Sew the Step 3 Pinwheel block to the right side of the Blueberries 6-1/2" square. Square to 12-1/2" x 6-1/2" as needed.



Block 4 - Lighthouse

Gather:

- [2] Pool 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles
- [2] Pool 2" squares
- [2] Pool 3-1/2" x 5" rectangles
- [2] Pool 4-1/2" x 7-1/2" rectangles
- [1] Indigo 1-1/2" x 4" rectangle
- [2] Indigo 1" x 2-1/2" rectangles
- [2] Indigo 1" x 4" rectangles
- [1] Canary 1" x 2-1/2" rectangle
- [2] Canary 1" x 4" rectangles
- [2] Cloud 2" x 4-1/2" rectangles
- [1] Cloud 1" x 3-1/2" rectangle
- [1] Cloud 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle
- [2] Cherry 2" x 4-1/2" rectangles
- [1] Cherry 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangle
- [1] Cherry 2" x 3-1/2" rectangle
- [2] Everglade 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles

1. Draw a diagonal line on the back of [2] Pool 2" squares. Place [1] on the left side of the Cherry 2" x 3-1/2" rectangle. Sew on the line and trim. Repeat for the right side for the Roof unit. Press according to arrows.



2. Make a strip set sewing together [2] Canary 1" x 4", [2] Indigo 1" x 4" and [1] Indigo 1-1/2" x 4" as shown. Press seams open. This unit is oversize for ease of piecing. Subcut [1] - 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" for the Window unit.



3. Sew the Roof unit from Step 1 to the Window unit from Step 2.
4. Sew a Cloud 1" x 3-1/2" strip to the bottom of the unit from Step 3.
5. Sew a Pool 3-1/2" x 5" rectangle to the right and left sides of the unit from Step 4..



6. Sew a Cherry 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangle in between [2] Pool 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles.



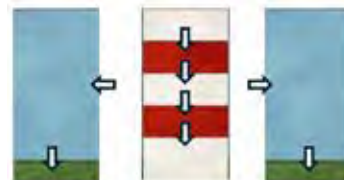
7. Sew unit from Step 6 to the bottom of the assembly from Step 5.



8. Alternating, sew [2] Cloud 2" x 4-1/2" rectangles with Cherry 2" x 4-1/2" rectangles.
9. Sew a 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle of Cloud to the bottom of unit from Step 8. Press as shown.



10. Sew an Everglade 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle to the bottom of the Pool 4-1/2" x 7-1/2" rectangle. Press to the Everglade. Make [2].
11. Sew this to the sides of the striped tower.



12. Sew to the bottom of the unit from Step 7. Press seam down. Square to 12-1/2" as needed.



Block 5 - Forests & Shoo-fly

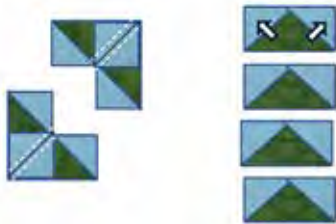
Gather:

- [8] Pool 2-1/2" squares
- [2] Pool 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles
- [1] Pool 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangle
- [2] Pool 3" squares
- [1] Everglade 4-1/2" square
- [1] Everglade 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangle
- [1] Indigo 2-1/2" square
- [2] Indigo 3" squares

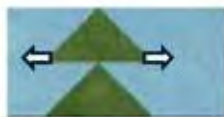
1. Place [2] Pool 2-1/2" squares on opposite corners of a Everglade 4-1/2" square, lining up the edges. Tip: Squares should be set in roughly a scant 1/16" from the edges. Sew a scant 1/4" on either side of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line. Press to the triangle.



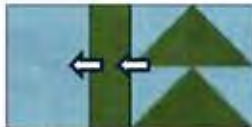
2. Place a Pool 2-1/2" square on the remaining corner of the Everglade Goose rectangle, lining up the edges. Squares should be set in roughly a scant 1/16" from the edges. Sew a scant 1/4" on either side of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line. Square to 2" x 3-1/2" as needed. Yields [4] Flying Geese.



3. Sew the flying geese together into [2] stacked pairs.
4. Sew a Pool 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangle to the left side of [1] flying geese set.
5. Sew a Pool 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangle to the right side of the unit from Step 4.



6. Sew a Pool 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangle to the left side of an Everglade 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangle.
7. Sew this unit to the left side of the remaining stacked geese set from Step 3.



8. Sew the units from Steps 5 and 7 together as shown. The block should measure 6-1/2".



9. Draw a diagonal line on the back of the Pool 3" squares. Place RST on the Indigo 3" squares. Sew 1/4" to either side of the line. Cut on the drawn line, yields [4] HSTs. Trim to 2-1/2".



10. Sew the HST units from Step 9 and the remaining Pool and Indigo 2-1/2" squares into a Shoo Fly 9-patch as shown.



11. Sew the Shoo Fly Block from Step 10 to the bottom of the Trees Block from Step 8. Square to 6-1/2" x 12-1/2" as needed.



Block 6 - Mountains

Gather:

- [2] Cloud 5-1/2" squares
- [2] Indigo 5-1/2" squares
- [1] Pool 5-1/2" square
- [1] Pool 5-1/4" square
- [1] Everglade 5" square
- [1] Everglade 5-1/4" square
- [1] Everglade 5-1/2" square
- [1] Sweetpea 5" square
- [1] Sweetpea 5-1/2" square

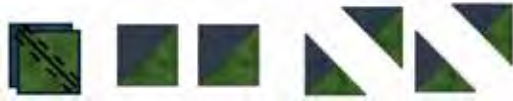
1. Draw a diagonal line on the back of [1] Cloud 5-1/2" square. Place RST on an Indigo 5-1/2" square. Sew 1/4" to either side of the line. Cut on drawn line, yields [2] HSTs. Do not trim.



2. Place a Pool 5-1/4" square on top of one of the HST units from Step 1. Draw a diagonal line corner to corner opposite the seam. Sew 1/4" on either side of the drawn line. Cut on drawn line, yields [2] QSTs. Square to 4-1/2".



3. Draw a diagonal line on the back of the Everglade 5-1/2" square. Place RST on an Indigo 5-1/2" square. Sew 1/4" to either side of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line, yields [2] HSTs. Do not trim. Cut both units in half on the diagonal.



4. Cut the remaining HST from Step 1 in half on the diagonal. Sew each half to a cut unit from Step 3 as shown. Watch the direction of the colors. Square to 4-1/2", yields [2] QSTs.



5. Cut an Everglade 5-1/4" square in half. Sew [1] triangle to [1] section of the cut HST unit from Step 3 as shown, yields [1] HST. Square to 4-1/2".



6. Cut a Pool 5-1/2" square in half then cut one of the triangles in half. Repeat with a Cloud 5-1/2" square and a Sweet Pea 5-1/2" square.



7. Sew a small Pool triangle to a small Cloud triangle. Sew a large Pool triangle to the long side, yields [1] HST. Square to 4-1/2".



8. Sew a small Sweet Pea triangle to a small Cloud triangle. Sew a large Sweet Pea triangle to the long side, yields [1] HST. Square to 4-1/2".



9. Draw a diagonal line on the back of a Sweet Pea 5" square. Place RST on an Everglade 5" square. Sew 1/4" to either side of the line. Cut on the drawn line, yields [2] HSTs. Square to 4-1/2".



10. Assemble the Mountain Block as shown. Sew units into rows. Then, sew the rows together. Square to 12-1/2" as needed.



Block 7 - Flying Geese and Forest

Gather:

- [6] Cloud 3-1/2" squares
- [1] Indigo 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangle
- [1] Everglade 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangle
- [1] Paprika 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangle
- [1] Forest 6-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangle

1. Draw a diagonal line on the back of the [6] Cloud 3-1/2" squares. Place a square RST on the left corner of the Indigo 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangle, lining up the edges. Sew on the line. Trim the corner to a 1/4" seam allowance. Press to the triangle. Repeat for the opposite corner. Square to 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" if needed.



2. Repeat Step 1 with the remaining Cloud squares and the Everglade and Paprika rectangles.



3. Sew the units together as shown. Block should measure 6-1/2" x 9-1/2".



4. Sew the Forest 6-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangle to the right side as shown. Square to 19-1/2" x 6-1/2" as needed.



Block 8 - Campgrounds

This is just the Campgrounds 6-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangle cut. No additional piecing required. Fabric is directional.

- [1] Pool 1-1/2" × 3-1/2" rectangle
- [1] Pool 1" × 3-1/2" rectangle
- [1] Cloud 4" × 2-1/2" rectangle
- [1] Cloud 2" × 2-1/2" rectangle
- [1] Cloud 2-1/2" × 5" rectangle
- [2] Cloud 1" squares

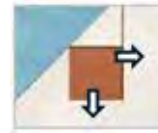
1. Sew a Cloud 2" × 2-1/2" rectangle to the top of a Paprika 2-1/2" square.
2. Sew a Cloud 2-1/2" × 4" Cloud rectangle to the left side of unit from Step 1.



3. Draw a diagonal line on the back of the Pool 4" square. Line this up on the left corner and sew on the line. Trim to 1/4" seam allowance.



4. Sew a Cloud 2" × 4" rectangle to the right side of the unit from Step 1.
5. Sew a Cloud 1-1/2" × 6" rectangle to the bottom.



6. Sew a Sweet Pea 2" × 6" strip to the top of a Canary 1-1/2" × 6" strip.
7. Sew this to the bottom of the Step 5 unit.
8. Sew a Pool 1-1/2" × 7-1/2" rectangle to the left side of Step 7 unit.



9. Draw a diagonal line on the back of [2] Paprika 1-1/2" squares and [2] Everglade 1-1/2" squares. Position on each corner of the Indigo 3-1/2" square, lining up the edges. Sew on the drawn line. Trim seam to 1/4". Press.



10. Sew a Everglade 1-1/2" × 3-1/2" piece to the bottom of the Step 9 unit.
11. Sew together end to end a Paprika 1" × 2-1/2" piece and a Everglade 1" × 2-1/2" piece.
12. Sew to the right side of the Step 10 unit.



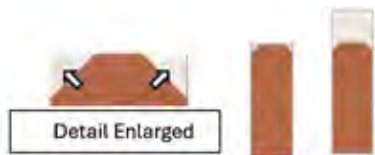
13. Draw a diagonal line on the back of a Paprika 2-1/2" square. Place RST together on the right corner of a Pool 2-1/2" × 3-1/2" rectangle as shown. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the seam allowance.

15. Sew this to the left side of the assembly from Step 12.

18. Draw a diagonal line on the back of a Pool 2-1/2" square. Place on the top corner of a Cloud 2-1/2" × 5" rectangle as shown. Sew on the line. Trim the seam allowance.
19. Sew a Sweet Pea 2-1/2" × 2" piece above a Canary 2-1/2" × 1-1/2" rectangle.
20. Attach the Step 19 unit to the bottom of the Step 18 unit.
21. Sew a Pool 1-1/2" × 7-1/2" rectangle to the right side.



22. Sew together a Pool 1" × 3-1/2" strip, Indigo 1" × 3-1/2" strip and a Pool 1-1/2" × 3-1/2" strip as shown.
23. Draw a diagonal line on the back of a Paprika 2-1/2" square. Line up on the upper left corner as shown. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the seam allowance.
24. Sew Step 23 unit to the bottom of the Step 21 unit.



25. Sew the units from Step 17 and Step 24 together as shown.
26. Sew a Sweet Pea 2-1/2" × 6" strip to the bottom of Step 25 unit.
27. Sew the Step 26 unit to the right side of the assembly from Step 16.



28. Sew a Pool 1-1/2" × 12-1/2" strip to the top. Square to 12-1/2" as needed.

- [5] Pool 2-1/2" squares
- [1] Pool 3-1/2" square
- [1] Pool 4-1/2" square
- [1] Cloud 3-1/2" square
- [1] Cloud 4-1/2" square
- [1] Cherry 1-1/2" × 5-1/2" rectangle
- [1] Cherry 3/4" × 5" rectangle
- [1] Indigo 1" × 6-1/2" rectangle
- [4] Indigo 2-1/2" squares
- [1] Coastal 6-1/2" × 12-1/2" rectangle

1. Sew together [5] Pool 2-1/2" squares and [4] Indigo 2-1/2" squares into a 9-patch block as shown. Block should measure 6-1/2" square.



2. Draw a diagonal line on the back of a Cloud 3-1/2" square. Place RST together on a Pool 3-1/2" square. Sew a scant 1/4" to either side of the line. Cut on the line. Square to 2-3/4". There will be [1] extra.



3. Repeat Step 2 with a Cloud 4-1/2" square and a Pool 4-1/2" square. Square to 4". There will be [1] extra.



4. Sew a Pool 1-3/4" × 3-3/4" rectangle to the top of the HST unit from Step 2 as shown. Sew a Pool 1-1/2" × 2-3/4" rectangle to the bottom.



5. Sew a Pool $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 4''$ rectangle to the bottom of the Step 3 HST.



6. Sew the units from Steps 4 and 5 to either side of a Cherry $3\frac{3}{4}'' \times 5''$ rectangle.



7. Draw a diagonal line on the back of [2] Pool $1\frac{1}{2}''$ squares. Place on the ends of a Cherry $5\frac{1}{2}'' \times 1\frac{1}{2}''$ rectangle going in opposite directions. Sew on the drawn lines. Trim the seam allowance.
8. Sew Pool $1'' \times 1\frac{1}{2}''$ rectangles to each end of the Step 7 unit.



9. Sew the Step 7 unit to the bottom of the assembly from Step 6 unit.
10. Sew an Indigo $1'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$ strip to the bottom. Block should measure $6\frac{1}{2}''$ square.



11. Sew the Sailboat block to the left side of the nine-patch block.
12. Sew the Coastal $12\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$ rectangle to the bottom. Square to $12\frac{1}{2}''$ as needed.

- [2] Cherry $3\frac{1}{2}'' \times 5''$ rectangles
- [1] Cherry $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6''$ rectangle
- [2] Everglade $3''$ squares
- [1] Everglade $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 1\frac{1}{2}''$ rectangle

1. Draw a diagonal line on the back of [2] Cherry $3''$ squares. Place RST on [2] Everglade $3''$ squares. Sew $\frac{1}{4}''$ on each side of the drawn line. Cut on the line, yields [4] HSTs. Square as needed to $2\frac{1}{2}''$.

2. Repeat Step 1 using [1] Cherry $3''$ square and [1] Pool $3''$ square. Yields [2] HSTs.



3. Sew together the [6] HSTs from Step 1 and Step 2 into a row as shown.



4. Repeat Step 1 with [1] Everglade $2''$ square and [1] Pool $2''$ square. Square HSTs as needed to $1\frac{1}{2}''$. There will be [1] extra.
5. Sew [1] HST from Step 4 to a Pool $1\frac{1}{2}''$ square.
6. Sew Step 5 unit to the right side of a Everglade $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 2\frac{1}{2}''$ rectangle.



7. Sew a Pool $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6''$ rectangle to the left side of the Step 6 unit. Then, sew a Pool $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 5''$ to the right side of the unit.



8. Sew a Cherry $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6''$ strip in between [2] Cloud $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6''$ strips. Subcut [2] - $1\frac{1}{2}''$ wide pieces from the strip set.



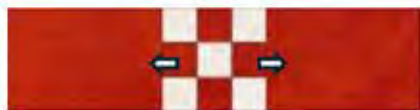

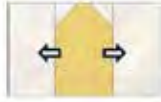

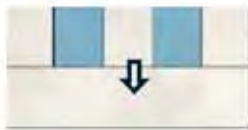

12. Sew a Pool $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 1\frac{1}{2}"$ rectangle to the bottom of the Step 11 HST.

13. Sew a Pool $1" \times 3\frac{1}{2}"$ rectangle to the right side of Step 12 unit.



14. Sew a Pool $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 3\frac{1}{2}"$ rectangle to the left side of the Canary $1" \times 3\frac{1}{2}"$ rectangle.

15. Sew this unit to the left side of the Step 13 unit.



16. Sew the Step 10 unit to the bottom of the Step 15 unit.

17. Sew a Pool $2" \times 6"$ rectangle to the left of the Step 16 unit.



18. Assemble the block as shown with the units from Steps 3, 5, 8 and 17. Square to $12\frac{1}{2}"$ as needed.

- [1] Pool $3\frac{1}{2}" \times 6\frac{1}{2}"$ rectangle
- [1] Indigo $3\frac{1}{2}" \times 6\frac{1}{2}"$ rectangle
- [2] Indigo $3\frac{1}{2}"$ squares
- [2] Paprika $3"$ squares
- [1] Paprika $2\frac{1}{2}"$ square

1. Draw a diagonal line on the back of [2] Pool $3\frac{1}{2}"$ squares. Place a square RST on the left corner of the Indigo $3\frac{1}{2}" \times 6\frac{1}{2}"$ rectangle, lining up the edges. 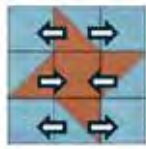

1. Draw a diagonal line on the back of [2] Pool 5" squares. Place RST on an Autumn Splendor 5" square. Sew 1/4" to each side of the drawn line. Cut on the line, yields [4] HST. Press open. Square to 4-1/2" as needed.



2. Cut a Pool 5" square in half on the diagonal. Align the centers of the triangle and the Paprika 1" × 7-1/2" rectangle. Sew with 1/4" seam. Repeat on the other side. Square as needed to 4-1/2".



3. Gather a 4-1/2" Cherry square and [1] Pool 4-1/2" square. Combine with the units from Step 1 and Step 2 and sew into rows as shown below. Square to 12-1/2" as needed.



Block 15 – Maple Syrup

Gather:

- [2] Indigo 3-1/2" × 6-1/2" rectangles
- [4] Cloud 3-1/2" squares
- [1] Syrup 6-1/2" square

1. Draw a diagonal line on the back of the [4] Cloud 3-1/2" squares. Place a square RST on the left corner of the Indigo 3-1/2" × 6-1/2" rectangle, lining up the edges. Sew on the line. Trim the corner to a 1/4" seam allowance. Repeat for the opposite corner. Square to 3-1/2" × 6-1/2" if needed. Make [2] Flying Geese.



2. Stack the Flying Geese units from Steps 1 and 2 as shown. Sew together. Block should measure 6-1/2".



3. Sew the Maple Syrup 6-1/2" square to the flying geese block as shown. Block should measure 6-1/2" × 12-1/2".



Block 16 – Pine Trees

Gather:

- [6] Pool 2" squares
- [2] Pool 2-1/2" squares
- [2] Pool 3" × 1-1/2" rectangles
- [2] Pool 1" × 2-1/2" rectangles
- [1] Everglade 3-1/2" × 2" rectangle
- [1] Everglade 5-1/2" × 2-1/2" rectangle
- [1] Everglade 6-1/2" × 2" rectangle
- [1] Paprika 1-1/2" square
- [1] Evergreen 6-1/2" square

1. Draw a diagonal line on the back of [2] Pool 2" squares. Place on the left corner of the Everglade 3-1/2" × 2" rectangle aligning the fabric edges. Sew on the drawn line. Trim to 1/4" allowance. Repeat for the right side.



2. Sew a Pool 2" square to each side of the Step 1 unit.



3. Repeat Step 1 with [2] Pool 2-1/2" squares and [1] Everglade 5-1/2" × 2-1/2" piece.



4. Sew a Pool 1" × 2-1/2" rectangle to each side.



5. Repeat Step 1 with [2] Pool 2" squares and the Everglade 6-1/2" × 2" piece.



6. Sew a Paprika 1-1/2" square in between [2] Pool 3" × 1-1/2" rectangles.



7. Sew the rows together as shown below. Square to 6-1/2" as needed.



8. Sew the 6-1/2" Evergreen square to the bottom. Square to 6-1/2" × 12-1/2" as needed.

- [1] Pool 4" square
- [6] Pool 2" squares
- [2] Pool 3-1/2" × 5-1/2" rectangles
- [1] Cloud 4" square
- [2] Cloud 2" × 6-1/2" rectangles
- [1] Cloud 5-1/2" × 4-1/2" rectangle
- [2] Cloud 2-1/2" × 3-1/2" rectangles
- [1] Cloud 2" × 12-1/2" rectangle
- [1] Indigo 2" × 3-1/2" rectangle
- [1] Indigo 1" × 6-1/2" rectangle
- [1] Cherry 1-1/2" × 6-1/2" rectangle

1. Draw a diagonal line on the back of [2] Pool 2" squares. Place on the corners of a Cloud 6-1/2" × 2" rectangle aligning the fabric edges. Sew on the drawn line. Trim to 1/4" allowance.

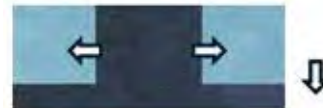

6. Sew a Pool 3-1/2" × 5-1/2" rectangle to right and left sides of the Step 5 unit.



7. Draw a diagonal line on the back of a 4" Pool square. Place RST on a Cloud 4" square. Sew 1/4" to each side of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line, yields [2] HSTs. Square to 3-1/2" as needed.



8. Sew each of the Step 7 HSTs to the top of a Cloud 2-1/2" × 3-1/2" rectangle as shown.



9. Sew a Cherry 1-1/2" × 4-1/2" rectangle to the right side of a Cloud 4-1/2" × 5-1/2" rectangle.

10. Sew a Cherry 1-1/2" × 6-1/2" rectangle across the top.



11. Sew the Step 8 units to the right and left sides of the Step 10 unit as shown.



12. Draw a diagonal line on the back of [2] Pool 2" squares. Place on the bottom corners of the Cloud 2" x 12-1/2" rectangle. Sew on the drawn line. Trim to 1/4" seam allowance.



13. Sew the Step 6 unit to the top of the Step 11 unit.
14. Sew the Step 12 unit to the bottom. Square to 12-1/2" as needed.



Block 18 - Harvest

Gather:

- [1] Pool 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangle
- [4] Pool 1-1/2" squares
- [1] Pool 3" square
- [1] Cherry 4-1/2" square
- [1] Sweet Pea 3" square
- [1] Apples 6-1/2" square
- [1] Forest 12-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangle
- [fabric is directional]

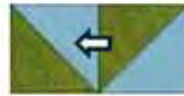
1. Draw a diagonal line on the back of [4] Pool 1-1/2" squares. Place on the corners of the 4-1/2" Cherry square. Sew on the drawn lines. Trim the seam. Press out to the corners.



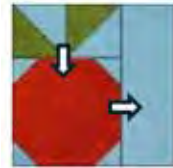

5. Sew a Pool 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangle to the right side as shown.



6. Sew a Apples 6-1/2" square to the left side of the Step 5 unit.
7. Sew a Forest 12-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangle to the bottom. Square to 12-1/2" as needed.



Block 19 - Apples Star Block

Gather:

- [1] Cloud 2-1/2" x 22" strip
- [1] Cloud 6" square
- [1] Cherry 2-1/2" x 22" strip
- [1] Apples 4-1/2" square
- [2] Apples 6" squares
- [1] Canary 6" square

1. Draw a diagonal line on the back of a Cloud 6" square and a Canary 6" square. Place RST on the Apples 6" squares. Sew 1/4" to each side of the drawn line. Cut on the line, yields [4] HSTs. Do not trim.



2. Place the Step 1 HST RST with the seams nesting. Colors should be opposite. Draw a diagonal line corner to corner opposite the seam. Sew 1/4" on either side of the drawn line. Cut in half on the drawn line, yields [4] QST. Square to 4-1/2".



3. Sew the Cloud $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 22"$ to the Cherry $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 22"$ strip lengthwise. Subcut into [8] $2\frac{1}{2}"$ units from the strip set.



4. Sew the Step 3 units into [4] 4-patch units. 4-patch blocks should measure $4\frac{1}{2}"$.



5. Sew a 4-patch units to the right and left side of [2] of the QST units, watching the direction of the squares as shown. Make [2].



6. Sew the remaining QST units to each side of the Apples $4\frac{1}{2}"$ square.



7. Assemble the rows from Steps 5 and 6 to create the star block as shown. Square to $12\frac{1}{2}"$ as needed.



QUILT ASSEMBLY:

1. Sew the Indigo $1\frac{1}{2}" \times 12\frac{1}{2}"$ and $1\frac{1}{2}" \times 19\frac{1}{2}"$ sashing strips to the blocks as shown creating rows. Assemble blocks into [4] rows.
2. Sew Indigo strips together as needed to obtain the required sashing strip size. In a perfect world, row sashing strips are $1\frac{1}{2}" \times 45\frac{1}{2}"$. Sew the [4] rows together with Indigo sashing strips in between.



BORDER ASSEMBLY:

1. **Inner border:** Measure the sides of the quilt top. Cut to that measurement.
2. Sew the $1\frac{1}{2}" \times 58\frac{1}{2}"$ inner border strips to right and left sides of the quilt top center. Press out to the border strips.
3. Sew together Indigo $1\frac{1}{2}"$ strips for the top and bottom inner border. Measure the width of the quilt. Cut [2] inner borders to that measurement. Add to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press out to the border strips.
4. **Outer border:** Sew the Lobsters outer border $5\frac{1}{2}" \times \text{WOF}$ strips into [4] sets of [2] each. Measure the sides of the quilt center. Cut [2] $5\frac{1}{2}" \times 60\frac{1}{2}"$ borders this size. Sew the outside borders to the quilt center.
5. Repeat for the top and bottom $5\frac{1}{2}" \times 57\frac{1}{2}"$ borders.



FINISHING:

1. Sew together Indigo $2\frac{1}{2}" \times \text{WOF}$ strips end to end for the binding.
2. Layer Quilt, Batting and Backing.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Bind with Indigo strips.
5. Label and Enjoy!
